

## **Via Public Transport**

It is likely that your pupils may be dilated at your eye examination, which can impair your vision and influence your ability to drive. As a result it is recommended that you either have someone drive you, or plan to wait for a period of time following the examination until you feel ready to drive.

## **Parking**

Located directly underneath the Octagon building is a Wilson carpark with the following rates:

### **TRAINS**

### Train from Central

At Central Train Station, go to Platform 18. Board any T1 train to Parramatta Station.

#### At Parramatta Train Station

Exit via Darcy Street (Exit 4, West concourse - use stairs or lift).

Turn right on to Darcy Street.

Turn left on to Smith Street. Follow Smith Street for 450m.

Turn Right on to Phillip Street.
Walk 90m and enter The Octagon
Building at 99 Phillip Street, opposite the
Yilabara Path, Laneway.

Facing forward, the entrance to the Cameron Centre is slightly to the right. The Centre for Eye Health is located within. Use the same entrance to Guide Dogs NSW/ACT, Parramatta Office.
